

LIVING WAGE

ADM

- → In most cases, a living wage is nearly double the federal minimum wage of \$7.25/hour and takes into account local costs of food, housing, medical care, transportation and other variables to ensure workers earn enough to support themselves, based on full-time work of 2080 hours/year.
- → We believe paying a living wage results in increased worker morale, worker health, increased efficiency and productivity, and improved quality of service. Offering a living wage in Colorado also lowers turnover rates, which saves the company money. The PetDine living wage standard means the company is able to attract and hire a higher level of talented, skilled workers.





GREENHOUSE GAS REDUCTION

GOAL: 100% of product to be made with renewable energy by 2025

- → We're 50% there
- → Solar Panels at Harvard continued to produce clean energy on-site
- → Panels produced a total of 2,077MWh of energy in 2021
- → This is the equivalent of greenhouse gas emission from 194 average cars driving for a year (1) or the electricity use of 175 homes for an entire year
- → While we did accomplish our renewable energy goal in our Harvard, IL facility, this is not currently a goal in our Colorado facilities based on supply chain challenges that conflict with other sustainability goals.

- → All liquid bottles and scoops for powders are PCR.

- → 75% of clients' products promote recyclability on packaging by 2023.
- → We are working with our clients one-on-one to promote recycling on packaging moving forward.
